# PRECAUTIONS FOR STORAGE, HANDLING & USE

DO NOT weld or apply heat to equipment or plant which may have contained fertiliser without first washing thoroughly to remove ALL fertiliser.







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#### Storage:

The basic requirements are the avoidance on involvement in a fire and contamination. Locate away from sources of heat, fire and explosion. Store at moderate temperatures in a dry, well-ventilated area. Keep away from combustible materials and chemical substances, taking care that it is not stored near hay, straw, grain, diesel oil, sawdust etc. Keep the storage areas clean, tidy and free from spillage.

DO NOT permit smoking or the use of naked lights in the storage area. Buildings used for storage should be dry and well ventilated. Stacks should be kept at least one meter from walls eaves and beams.

#### Handling & Use:

Avoid handling which leads to dust formation. Avoid spilling, skin and eye contact. Use in accordance with manufacturers advice. Do not exceed recommended rates of application.

#### **Personal Protection:**

Provide adequate general and local exhaust ventilation. Use with local exhaust ventilation to minimise dust levels. Wear respirator if there is dust formation. Dust filter P2 (for fine dust). Use protective gloves. Wear eye goggles, keep eye-wash handy. Wash hands after use and before eating, smoking and using toilet.

#### **SPILLAGE**

Do not breathe dust. Wear personal protective equipment. Use a respirator. Extinguish naked flames and remove all sources of ignition. Keep away from drains, water courses and soil. Shovel into dry containers. Cover and move the containers. Flush the area with water. Dispose of in accordance with local authority requirements.
